



Keyboard and Mouse are two important parts of a computer. Let us take a closer look at these two important parts.

### Keyboard

A keyboard is an input device of the computer. It has many keys on it. Keys are used for typing letters, numbers and symbols. When a key is pressed, the corresponding character appears on the screen.






When you open a document or click in a text box to type, you will see a small blinking vertical line. This blinking line is called cursor. It tells you where you are going to start typing on the page or screen.




# Shift Key

There are two Shift keys on a keyboard. The shift key is used **♦** Shift in combination with other keys. The number keys have some symbols on them. To type these symbols, one has to press the Shift key and Number Key together. It is also used to type capital letters when the Caps Lock is off.



# Backspace Key

The Backspace key works like an eraser. It erases the letter or number typed on the left of the cursor.



# K N O W — M O R E

Hotkeys are combinations of keys that when pressed at the same time let you quickly access/open menus using only your keyboard.





### Handling a Mouse

A mouse is an input device. It looks like a real mouse. It is small in size and has a tail which is attached to CPU.



A mouse has either two or three buttons. The left button is used for left click and the right button is used for right click. A mouse helps us to move the pointer, select items and draw pictures on the computer screen.

#### Mouse Pad

The pad on which we move the mouse is known as Mouse Pad.

#### Mouse Pointer

The slant arrow on the screen is called the Mouse Pointer. As we move the mouse, the pointer on the monitor also moves in the same direction.

#### Mouse Actions

While using the mouse, we perform different actions to do different kinds of work. Let us learn about them.



Pressing the left mouse button once is called a click. We gently press and release the left button of the mouse to select an item on the computer screen.






Selected item



## NOW-MORE

The busy pointer icons  $\mathbb{Z}$   $\mathbb{C}$  can be an hourglass or a spinning circle. It means the computer is busy processing information.







- A keyboard is an input device which is used for entering data into the computer.
- The Shift key is used for typing the letters in CAPITAL when the Caps Lock is off.
- The Caps Lock key is used for typing capital letters.
- The Backspace key is used for deleting the letters to the left side of the cursor.
- The Delete key erases the letters to the right side of the cursor.
- The mouse is a pointing device used for pointing and selecting items on monitor.
