


We use pencil or pen to write in our notebooks. Likewise, we use keyboard to type on a computer.

Computer keyboard is an important part of a computer. It has many small buttons, which are called as **Keys**.

A keyboard is used for typing words, letters, numbers etc.

There are three types of keys on the keyboard.




The modern day computer keyboard is based on the QWERTY layout designed by the inventor of typewriter 'Christopher Latham Sholes'.



SPECIAL KEYS

Some keys on the keyboard perform special functions like typing in capital or small letters, giving space, deleting characters, etc. and are called as **Special Keys**. We will study some of them here.



SHIFT KEY

Shift Key is used to capitalize lower case letters. To capitalize a letter, hold down the Shift key as you press the letter. There are 2 Shift keys on the keyboard.



CAPS LOCK KEY

The Caps Lock Key is used to type capital letters. When the Caps Lock key is pressed, you see a green light towards the top-right corner of the keyboard. This indicates that the letters typed now would be capital letters. Press it again to turn off the key.



ENTER KEY

Enter Key is used to move the cursor to the next line. It is also called as Return key. There are 2 Enter keys on the keyboard.
